Kingston Chase Home Owners Association Board Meeting Minutes of March 9, 2020



Call to Order

- Board President Andy Cassell called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.
- Board members present: Kerry Buss, Steve Kapushoc, Pat Kollar, Jack McDonald, and Deke Smith,
- Others present: Marsha Cassell, Administrative Assistant; and Shannon McClain and Jeanette Murphy, Swim Team.

Secretary's Report – February Minutes were approved as published in March *Crier*.

Treasurer's Report – There is \$78,666 in checking and \$241,097 in CDs (this includes the CD not yet transferred to checking).

Member Business

- Girl Scout Troop 51030 asked via letter to add recycling bins to the interior of the clubhouse. Bins will be added and clubhouse users will need to empty them after each use—as outlined in the clubhouse contract regarding trash.
- A homeowner inquired as to why Kingston Chase does not use the county trash service. The HOA has considered it in the past, however, 75% of the neighborhood would have to buy into the service in order for the county to provide service. Leaf removal is extra. The Board will revisit this at a later time.

Committee Reports

ARC – The Architectural Review Committee still needs volunteers to join and support its efforts.

<u>Buildings and Maintenance</u> – One of the baby swings at the pool playground needs to be replaced.

<u>Landscape</u> – No report.

Conservation Corps – No report.

Neighborhood Watch - No report.

Newsletter – No report.

Playgroup – Little Tykes soccer may start soon.

Pool – No report.

Social – No report.

Swim Team – Swim Team Open House is scheduled for May 1 at the clubhouse.

Old Business

- Declaration Revision status: 84 of 537 votes received (15.6%) to date.
- Pavilion project: Discussion surrounded two options: 1) Proceed with current plans and attempt to get approval from the county, which may be unlikely due to the location of the deck in relation to the stormwater easement. 2) Move proposed pavilion to a new location where the picnic tables are currently. No decision was made—the Board will inquire more about the process of approval, price, and likelihood of receiving approval.

New Business

• Swim Team asked to be included under the HOA. They are currently at a disadvantage when it comes to constantly changing leadership, insurance, taxes, and do not want to pursue non-profit status. The Board is in favor of the request, but needs to check with the HOA lawyers about any potential problems with non-resident participation.

There was no Executive Session. Meeting adjourned at 8:29 p.m.
