Kingston Chase Celebrates Easter

Kingston Chase will hold its annual Easter Celebration on Sunday, March 28, when the Easter Bunny will travel through Kingston Chase to wave to the families and children. The Bunny Ride will start at 10:00 am. The KCHOA website will include tracking information and the planned route of travel as the date comes closer. Then, starting at 11:00 a.m., there will be an Easter Egg Hunt in groups of 25 children at a time held in the pool parking lot. In order to participate in the egg hunt, each child must register separately online at https://www.kchoa.org/calendar/2021/2/18/easter-egg-hunt-must-sign-up no later than Friday, March 26. Sign-up will begin March 15. No worries, there is room for everyone! Please note the following important information:

- Please sign up each child in your family that will participate.
- When signing up, you will be asked to answer the standard Covid questions. If any criteria changes for anyone in your family prior to the Egg Hunt, please do not participate.
- This event is for Kingston Chase residents only. Due to Covid-19, there can be no relatives that do not live in Kingston Chase.
- Children will be limited to collecting a specific number of eggs.
 Please discuss this with your children so they know what to expect.
 Adults must wear masks at all times, even though the event is being held outdoors. Social distancing guidelines will need to be followed.
- Please arrive promptly at your designated time and leave promptly when done in order to keep numbers in the parking lot low.
- The clubhouse will not be open during the Easter event.

Kingston Chase Home Owners Association Board Meeting Minutes of February 8, 2021



Call to Order

- Board president Andrew Cassell called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.
- Board members present via Zoom conference: Jen Baez, Chris Buley, Rosemary Buley, Kerry Buss, Steve Kapushoc, Mike Klinker, Jack McDonald, Joe Seeger, and Deke Smith.
- Others present: Marsha Cassell, Administrative Assistant; Shannon McClain, Swim Team; and Scott Mabry, homeowner.

Secretary's Report – January Minutes were approved as published in the February Crier.

Treasurer's Report – There is \$62,529 in checking and \$261,065 in CDs.

Member Business – None.

Committee Reports

<u>ARC</u> – The ARC will discuss implementing Zoom monthly meetings to replace clubhouse meetings in lieu of e-mail approvals. <u>Buildings and Maintenance</u> – Fencing around the transformer at the pool clubhouse needs to be replaced. The Board will collect estimates for the project.

<u>Landscape</u> – A rotten railroad tie between the playground and picnic table will be replaced.

Conservation Corps – No report.

Neighborhood Watch – No report.

Newsletter – No report.

<u>Playgroup</u> – No report.

<u>Pool</u> – The Herndon Swim League asked for documentation outlining last year's pool opening process, as Kingston Chase was one of the few communities able to open successfully. Deke prepared and shared detailed procedures and guidelines.

<u>Swim Team</u> – The Board approved using a company to guide the Swim Team through the process of obtaining 501(c)3 status and complete its separation from the HOA.

Tennis – No report.

Old Business

- 232 of 537 (43%) of Kingston Chase lots have voted in favor of the Declaration Revision. 403 votes (75%) are needed for it to pass.
- 2019 Reserve contribution was deposited in Northwest Federal Credit Union savings account.

New Business

- Complaint re: long-term RV parked on Fantasia Drive. The Board will have the ARC send a letter as the first step.
- Board member question: Will vaccinations affect pool usage? Answer: No. Social distancing/masking guidelines will continue to be in place. Vaccination numbers may not be high by pool opening and CDC recommends continued masking even after vaccination.
- Board will need to vote to extend clubhouse/pool use rights to Swim Team once they are a separate entity.

There was no Executive Session.

Meeting adjourned at 8:11 p.m.

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




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2021 Annual Assessment
