### Kingston Chase Annual Board of Director Elections Will Be Held December 13

Ingston Chase will hold its annual Board of Director elections at its December meeting scheduled for Monday, December 13. There are three terms that expire at the end of the year. While incumbents often return for another term, there is one seat this election cycle that will be open and each year presents an opportunity for others to step up and be included in the election process. The 3-year term runs from January 1, 2022 and continues through December 31, 2024. ### Report Malfunctioning Streetlights to Dominion Energy

A ttractive streetlights line our neighborhood roads and are installed for the safety of pedestrians and drivers out in the dark and also serve as a deterrent to vandalism or mischief. As you walk through the neighborhood at night or look outside your own home you may notice a streetlight malfunctioning (on when it should be off, off when it should be on, or having intermittent on/off patterns). If the light is on a public street, it is most likely a streetlight. Streetlight malfunctions need to be reported by calling 1-866-DOM-HELP (1-866-366-4357) or complete and e-mail the form available at the following link <a href="https://www.dominionenergy.com/virginia/report-outage-or-emergency/streetlight-outages">https://www.dominionenergy.com/virginia/report-outage-or-emergency/streetlight-outages</a>.

You may need to provide the pole number located directly on the pole and/or the nearest street address. Most importantly, do not assume someone else has reported the malfunction. Dominion Energy is very good about acting promptly on fixing these reported streetlight issues, even intermittent problems.

### Kingston Chase Home Owners Association Board Meeting Minutes of October 11, 2021



### Call to Order

- Board President Andrew Cassell called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.
- Board members present: Jen Baez, Steve Kapushoc, Mike Klinker, Jack MacDonald, Deke Smith, and Todd Waldrop.
- Others present: Marsha Cassell, Administrative Assistant; Phyllis Sisolak, AA new hire; and Kristine Covey, Playgroup.

Secretary's Report – August and September Minutes approved as published in the September and October Criers, respectively.

**Treasurer's Report** – As of 9/30/2021 there is \$129,002 in checking and \$261,582 in CDs. 2021 dues payments received from 535 out of 537 homes, Herndon Crossing pool memberships received from 7 homes, and HOA home sales disclosure packets purchased was 21.

### **Member Business**

- Kristene Covey was introduced as the new Chairperson for the Children's Corner and Playgroup.
- The ARC received a complaint about a residence with garbage cans permanently curbside. It was noted that both the residents and homeowner have been sent multiple infraction notices. The Board will draft a letter to be sent to the lawyers for follow-up.

### **Committee Reports**

<u>ARC</u> – Eight applications were received; 6 were approved, 1 was held for more study, and 1 needs more details. The ARC will consider implementing a procedure for applications to be due the Thursday before the monthly ARC meeting.

<u>Buildings and Maintenance</u> – At the request of a homeowner, bolts were tightened on some equipment on the playground. It was noted that two hard-wired smoke alarms in the clubhouse were missing.

<u>Landscape</u> – A damaged tree was removed from the cemetery on Permit Court. There is another tree near the pool that needs removing and one by the tennis court. Mowing of the common grounds went well this year and there is one more scheduled that will accommodate the Little Tykes soccer.

Conservation Corps – No report.

<u>Neighborhood Watch</u> – There have been incidents where items were removed from parked vehicles in Kingston Chase. A notice will be put in the next *Crier* reminding people to secure their vehicles and hide or store valuables elsewhere.

Newsletter – No report.

Playgroup – The first meeting will be held in November, with funds available for playgroup to use.

<u>Pool</u> – All closing activities have been completed. Board members in attendance voted to accept the bid by NV Pools, our current provider, to continue services for the 2022 pool season.

Social - No report.

Swim Team – No report.

Tennis – No report.

Welcome - One home was welcomed.

### **Old Business**

- 300 of 537 (56%) of Kingston Chase lots have voted in favor of the Declaration Revision. 403 votes (75%) are needed for it to pass. There may be a Postcard Vote Mailing Option in the future.
- The clubhouse re-key is under review.

### **New Business**

- The 2022 budget meeting will be held prior to the November Board meeting.
- 2021 elections will take place in December. One Board member, Kerry Buss, is not seeking reelection.
- The Electronic Voting Resolution will be discussed in the December meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
